MU HOW TO MAKE A PREHISTORIC SEA MARINE REPTILE PUPPET


MATERIALS

- monster templates (in your kit)
- split pins (in your kit)
- chopsticks or pop sticks (in your kit)
- stickers (in your kit)
- Sticky tape

INSTRUCTIONS



1. Assemble the plesiosaur, mosasaur and icthyosaur bodies as shown in the diagram, using split pins to secure jaws, flippers and other body parts together.




2 Decorate the sea monster with stickers, you could also use textas and other collage materials.




3. Turn over your templates to the undecorated side. Add chopsticks to the tail, body or flippers of each animal using plenty of sticky tape. You might want to test the positions you place the sticks in to see what is best for your puppet to move well.

Now you're ready to bring those marvellous mezozoic monsters to life.
