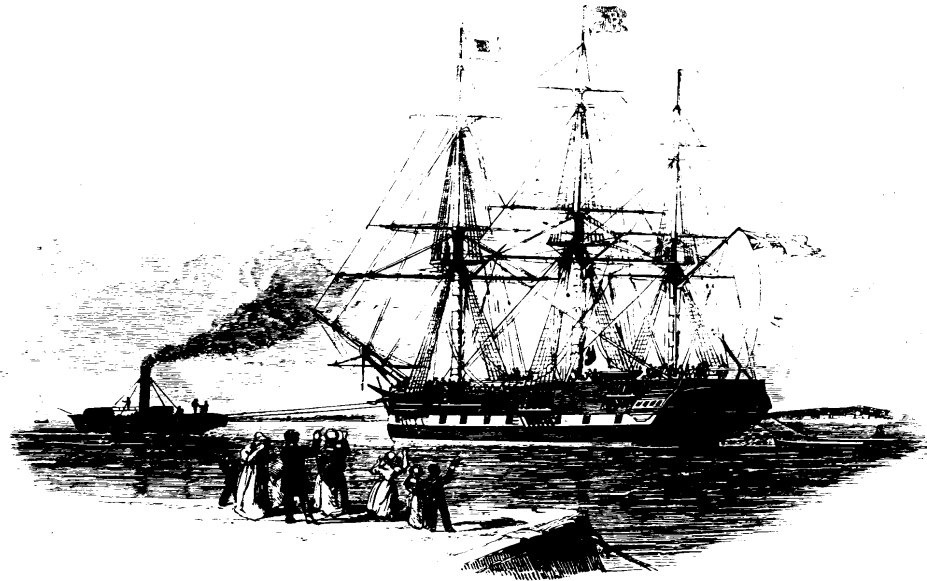

Acknowledgements

This index has been prepared with the generous assistance of the staff of the Mitchell Library pictures Section, State Library of New South Wales.

Some issues of the Australasian Sketcher are held by the General reference Library, State Library of New South Wales. This index was compiled from these issues and from the microfilm held at the same location.

Compilers Note

It should be realised that illustrations of casualties such as shipwrecks or collisions may not necessarily depict the vessels accurately, since the artist was rarely on the scene. In some cases, however, it seems probable that the artist was able to refer to “file” illustrations of the vessel in happier days, and adapt them to a new situation.

A few of the illustrations are of distant views as, for example of immigrant ships surrounded by icebergs in the Southern Ocean.

Some of the later illustrations were drawn from photographs which may be available in other collections.

SECTION 1

Introduction

Many libraries and other organisations receive requests from family and local historians and others seeking the likenesses of ships which brought people to Australia and New Zealand in the nineteenth century. The search can be very time-consuming, and very frustrating because there are comparatively few portraits of named ships available in public collections here or overseas for the period up to the last quarter of the nineteenth century, when photography became more common.

However, the AUSTRALASIAN SKETCHER (AS) contains a wealth of pictorial material on a wide variety of subjects, including ships and the sea, and can help bridge this gap.

The AUSTRALASIAN SKETCHER was first published in Melbourne in 1873, and continued in monthly or fortnightly editions until 1889. From May 15, 1875 to October 29, 1885 it was printed in South Australia. After December 26, 1889 it was incorporated into the Australasian, the fore-runner of the magazine AUSTRALASIAN POST, which first appeared in April 1946.

A complete run of the AUSTRALASIAN SKETCHER is held by the National Library of Australia, Canberra and by State Libraries of Victoria and South Australia. A nearly complete run is held by the State Library of New South Wales, and part runs by other State Libraries. There is also a reprint in facsimile of 1880 issues, published by Heritage Press, Melbourne in 1970, but this is of illustrations only and the pagination differs from the original.

The AUSTRALASIAN SKETCHER was published every four weeks from the first issue of April 19, 1873 until the issue of December 20, 1879. For the period January 17, 1880 to August 26, 1882 inclusive it was published fortnightly and thereafter on a four-weekly basis until the last issue of December 26, 1889.

The standard of illustration varies, and not all illustrations of ships can be accepted as reliable, particularly in the case of scenes of shipwreck or other casualties. In several cases, too, the night scene of a casualty is depicted with more attention to darkness than detail. The index to the ILLUSTRATED LONDON NEWS and ILLUSTRATED SYDNEY NEWS should be checked before using any illustration from the

AUSTRALASIAN SKETCHER, as the artistic and technical standards of the former are generally to be preferred. In some cases, also, it appears likely that the local artist has copied the London illustration.

The final four or five volumes of the AUSTRALASIAN SKETCHER concentrate more on serial stories and ladies' fashion news than on new and other topics of interest for the purpose of this index.

Ship Photographic File

In addition to collections of photographs, many libraries also maintain files of cutting which include many ship portraits.
