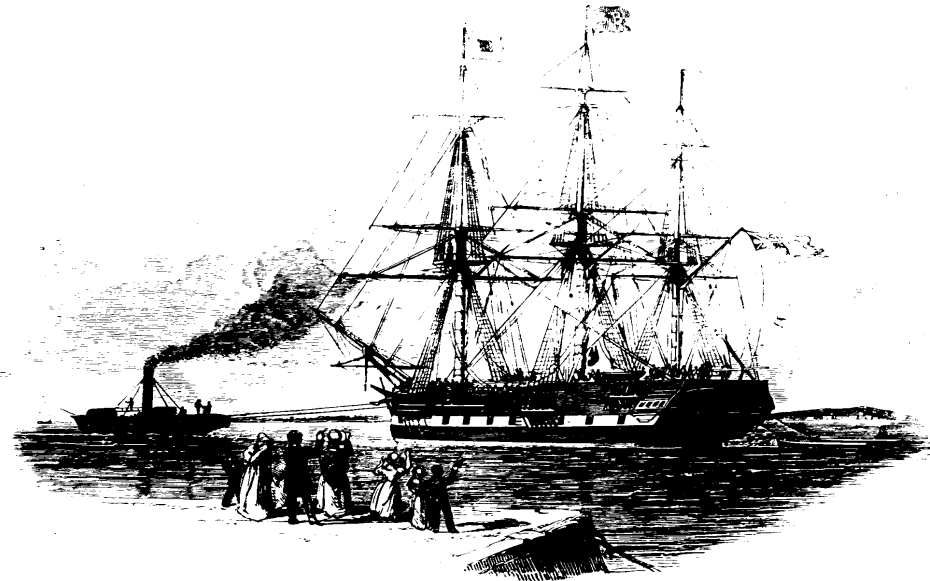

SECTION 1

Introduction

Many Libraries and other organisations receive requests from family and local historians and others seeking the likenesses of ships which brought people to Australia and New Zealand in the nineteenth century. The search can be very time – consuming, and very frustrating because there are comparatively few portraits of named ships available in any public collections here or overseas for the period up to the last quarter of the nineteenth century, when photography became more common.

However, the ILLUSTRATED LONDON NEWS (ILN) contains a wealth of pictorial material on a wide variety of subjects, including ships and the sea, and can help to bridge this gap. Publication of the ILN commenced in 1842. Many major libraries have files of this publication in its original form or on microfilm.

The task of indexing the maritime illustration was undertaken to cover the first fifty years of publication, up to and including 1891, so as to overlap the “photographic age “ adequately. Except for a few years the beginning and end of this period, the general standard of engraving, particularly that by E. Weedon, was high from both technical and artistic viewpoints.

The complete index of all ship and general maritime illustrations, covering about 1,800 items and in excess of 2,000 entries, is held by the Mitchell Library, State Library of New South Wales. It is intended to publish a complete listing in the near future.

The following list comprises a selection of entries of specific relevance to Australia and New Zealand. It includes ships of the P & O “feeder “ lines, and some ships built for the Australian and New Zealand trades but which were diverted to other trades.

Where specific sailing ship portrait cannot be located in the main index , or in any other collection, an illustration of a ship of similar rig, size and period can be selected from the following two sections, to give a general idea of the appearance of the required ship. These sections will facilitate also the selection of illustrations of typical ships that might have been seen on an emigrant voyage in any decade.

The next section lists all general emigrant scenes, and includes a number of detailed illustrations of scenes on deck and below.

The final sections are of general items such as view of ports or places where emigrant ships called, and specific Australian and New Zealand references.

Ship Photographic File

In addition to collections of photographs, many libraries also maintain files of cutting which include many ship portraits. It is of course, advisable to check also the index to original paintings and other original works – in the Mitchell Library of the State Library of NSW., for example, is a separate index for ship portraits held in the pictures collection.

* In each case there is a caption or article on the same page, or elsewhere in the same issue.

It should be realised that illustrations of casualties such as shipwrecks or collisions may not necessarily depict the vessels accurately, since the artist was rarely on the scene. In some cases, however, it seems probable that the artist was able to refer to “file” illustrations of the vessels in happier days, and to adapt them to the new situation.

On the other hand, many illustrations of newly launched ships appear to have been drawn from a study of the shipbuilder’s Plan’s and, particularly where the ships are shown in broadside, they are probably as accurate as a photograph would have been.

A few of the illustrations are merely distant views as for example, of immigrant ships surrounded by icebergs in the Southern Ocean.

Some of the later illustrations were drawn from photographs which may be available in other collections.
