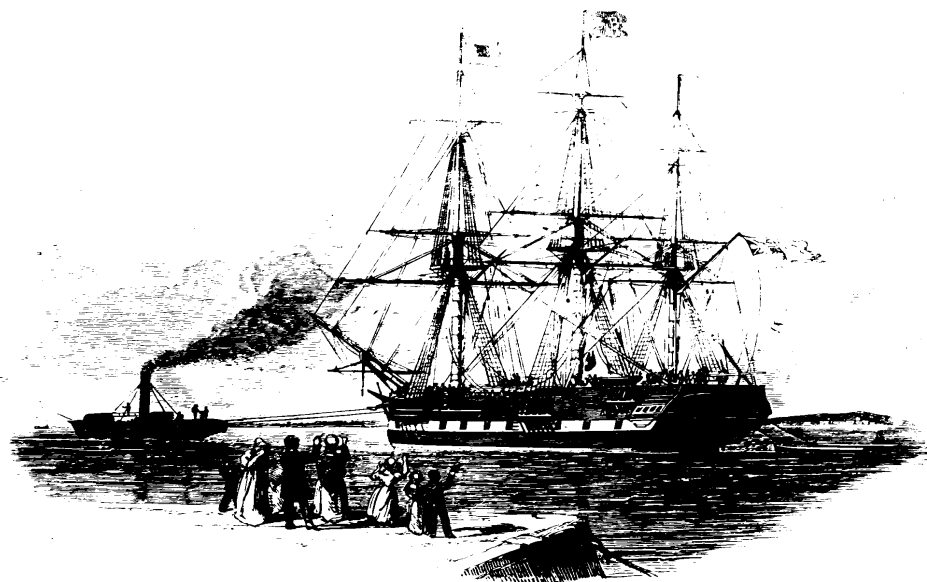

Compilers Note

It should be realised that illustrations of casualties such as shipwrecks or collisions may not necessarily depict the vessels accurately, since the artist was rarely on the scene. In some cases, however, it seems probable that the artist was able to refer to “file” illustrations of the vessel in happier days, and adapt them to a new situation.

A few of the illustrations are merely distant views as, for example of immigrant ships surrounded by icebergs in the Southern Ocean.

Some of the later illustrations were drawn from photographs which may be available in other collections.

SECTION 1

Introduction

Many Libraries and other organisations receive requests from family and local historians and others seeking the likenesses of ships which brought people to Australia and New Zealand in the nineteenth century. The search can be very time – consuming, and very frustrating because there are comparatively few portraits of named ships available in any public collections here or overseas for the period up to the last quarter of the nineteenth century, when photography became more common.

However, the ILLUSTRATED SYDNEY NEWS (ISN) contains a wealth of pictorial material on a wide variety of subjects, including ships and the sea, and can help to bridge this gap.

Publication of the ISN commenced in October 1853, and continued as a weekly for ninety issues until June 1855. A new monthly series commenced in June 1864. In 1868 the frequency was changed to four-weekly, in 1866 to monthly, and from June 1889 to fortnightly. In April 1872 the publication incorporated the NEW SOUTH WALES AGRICULTURALIST AND GRAZIER. The numbering of volumes was somewhat erratic, as is seen from the table below.

Indexing was continued only up to the end of 1889 because, for some of the later years, the publication had become more of a story magazine than a news magazine, and the number of maritime illustrations declined in both number and quality. In the case of this and the compiler's index of the ILLUSTRATED LONDON NEWS it was considered that there are sufficient photographic collections available to the public, illustrating ships of this period onwards, to make unnecessary an index to sometimes fanciful line drawings from illustrated journals of whatever origin.

The general standard of engraving in the ILLUSTRATED SYDNEY NEWS does not compare well with that of the ILLUSTRATED LONDON NEWS and, in many instances, one can only hope to get a reasonable impression of a ship rather than a true likeness. This is particularly so in the case of illustrations of casualties, where artistic license often seems to have been given too free a hand. There are some instances where the local artist appears to have copied an engraving from an overseas journal, often from the ILLUSTRATED LONDON NEWS.

Ship Photographic File

In addition to collections of photographs, many libraries also maintain files of cutting which include many ship portraits.
