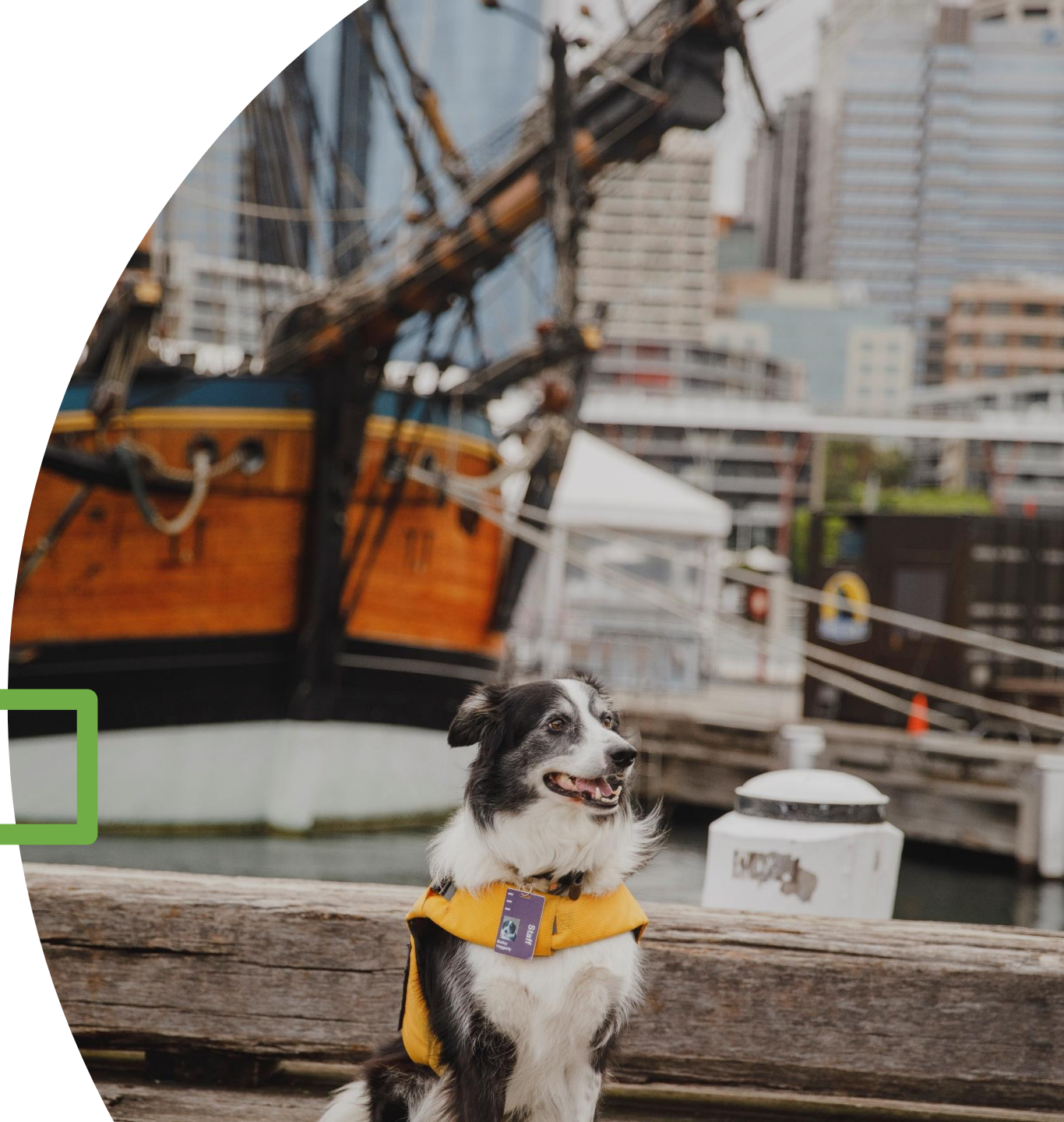
The seagull gang aren't very nice to our visitors. They steal their food and they really make a mess around the museum for my museum friends to clean up. You say they are **poo monsters!**

towards the museum.

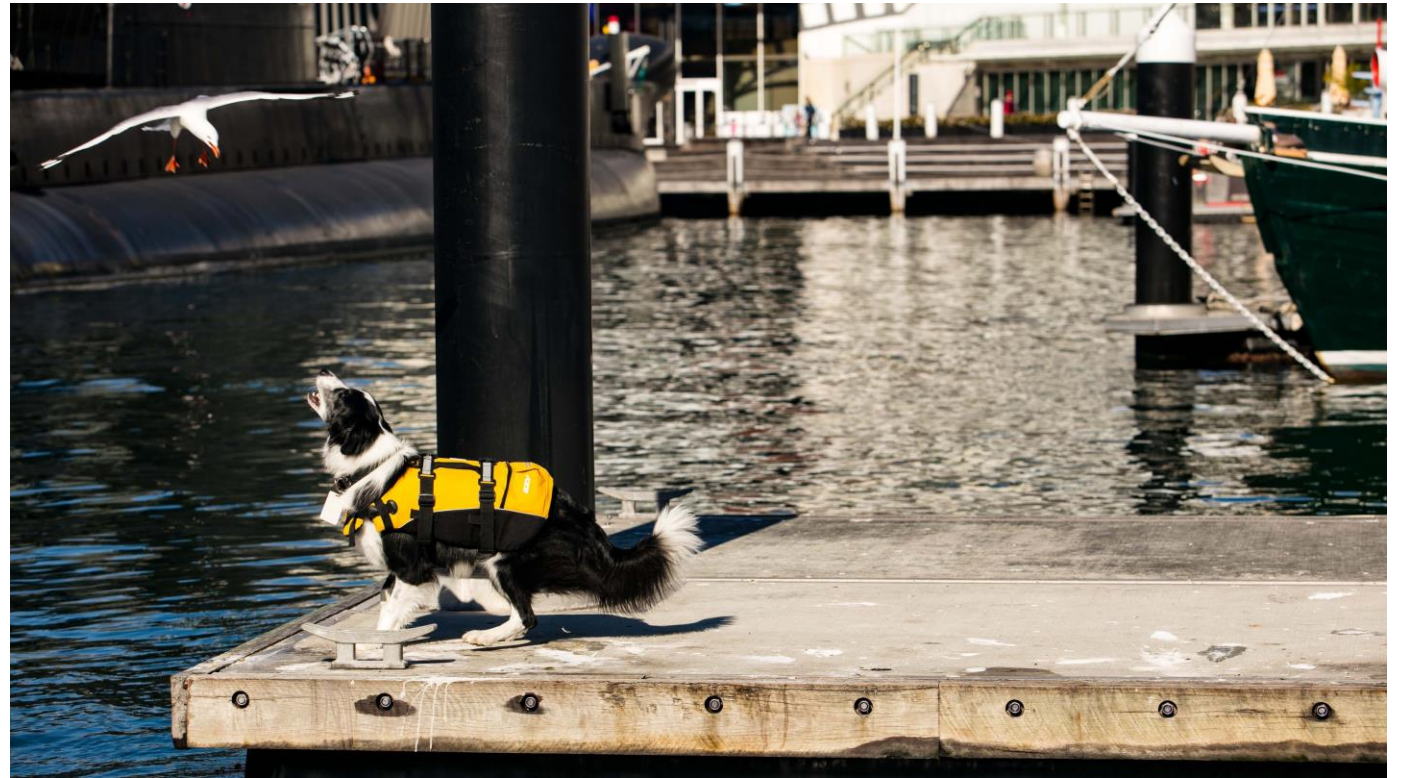
Lets get moving!




Sam and his buddies have sat down **on** the wharves near the water and are planning their mischief. I will tell them to go away.

Why is that? Because they are so friendly!

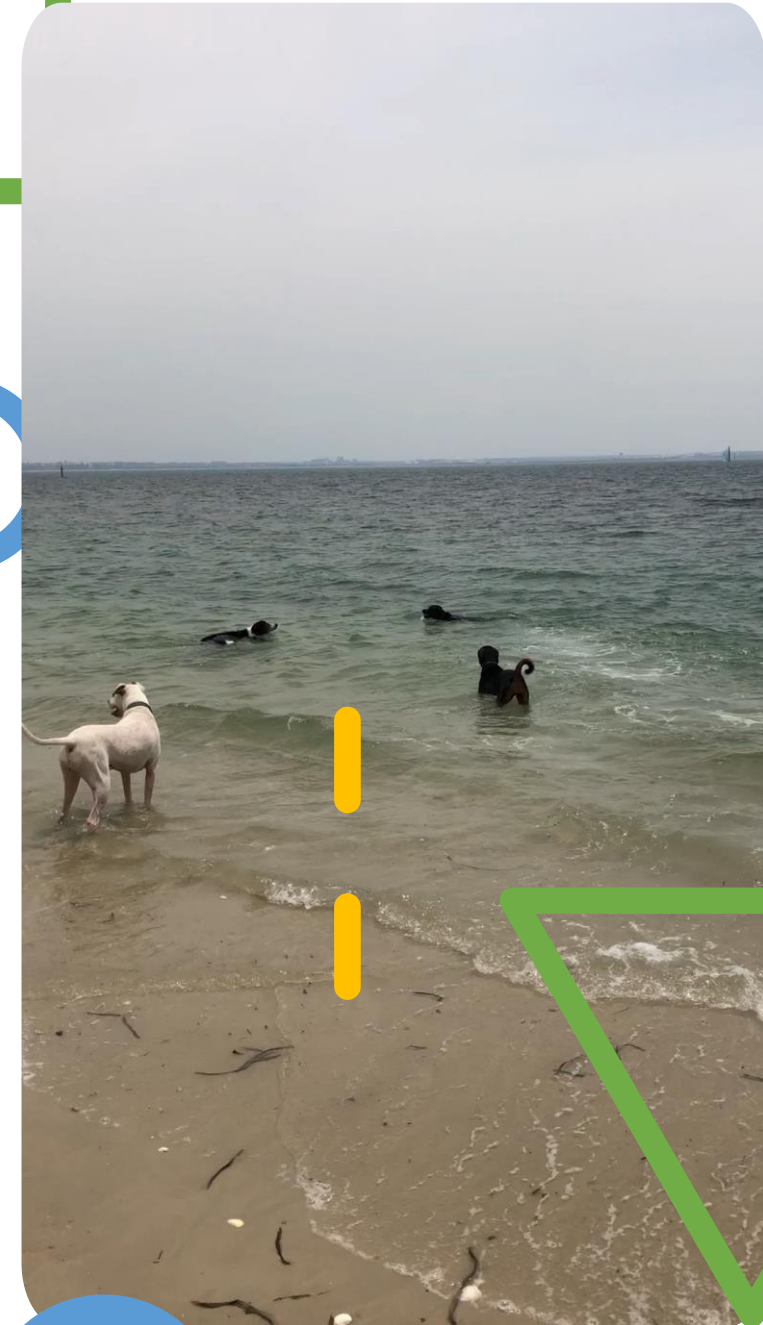
We often get seals visiting the museum and Sydney Harbour.
